




Empowering Literacy - Strategies for Parents


Starfish Back Pack Program

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week.

With School Cash Online, parents have the convenient and secure option of paying for school items—using their credit card online or chequing account, 24/7. You can pay for school items such as trips, club/athletic fees. It will save you time too! To access online payments, please register at:
