Financial


2024/25 Total Collected \$ 8,079.25 2024/25 Total Costs \$ 4,892.20*

By and large the most profitable food events were ones we did "in-house", including corn dog lunch, PI day pizza & pie, snack days and hot dog lunch (projected).

We allowed roughly 1 week to 10 days between order form distribution and due date. Generally, purchased items for sale were marked up 30%, rounded to the nearest quarter. Items such as chips were priced in accordance with our movie night

pricing. (\$2/bag). We also increased popcorn prices in January of 2025 to \$2/bag as the purchase price of popcorn packets keeps increasing.
